English	
<p>In English we will continue to build upon and develop skills in Reading, Writing and Phonics. We will also be developing the use of cursive handwriting from the beginning of the year.</p> <p>In our first unit and to link in with the City of Culture, we will be researching Amy Johnson and different types of transport focussing on flight. We will write labels, lists signs and captions while focussing on basic skills such as sentence structure and punctuation.</p>	
Mathematics	
<p>In Maths, we will revise and develop our understanding of numbers up to 100 including counting in ones, twos, fives and tens as well as learning number bonds to 10 and 20 by heart. We will also look at place value, number patterns and sequences and addition and subtraction. We make these concepts as fun and as practical as possible by using concrete experiences as a basis and learning on a larger scale using the outdoor environment. We will also be looking at 2D and 3D shapes and Money.</p>	
Science	
<p>We will be investigating aeroplanes and flight and testing out some of our own aeroplanes. We will also be learning about seasonal changes and how the seasons affect plant growth.</p>	
Geography	
<p>We will be talking about Amy Johnson and finding out the different places she visited and where they are on a map of the world, focussing on geographical language. We will also be using observational skills to place key features and places in Hull onto maps and learn to use map reading skills to help us find our way around.</p>	
History	
<p>We will be learning about the historical figure Amy Johnson and what great things she achieved in her lifetime. We will also be thinking about different types of transport and how it might have changed over the years and we will visit the transport museum in Hull city centre.</p>	
Computing	
<p>We will be using iPads and computers to research Amy Johnson as well as learning about e-safety and how to keep ourselves safe online. We will also be looking at finding and using online resources.</p>	
Design and technology	
<p>We will look at different types of aircrafts and make our own aeroplane using different techniques. We will also be designing and making a seasonal calendar using different textiles.</p>	
Art and design	
<p>We will be drawing different modes of transport using a range of media. We will also be drawing and painting self, and family portraits using different techniques. We will be making Hull Fair sculptures and exploring different textures for our bonfire night pictures.</p>	
Music	
<p>We will be learning topic related songs and chants, playing simple percussion instruments and recording the sounds we make.</p>	
Physical Education	
<p>We will be developing our basic skills in Gymnastic s, football and dance.</p>	
Religious Education	
<p>We will start by exploring why we are special and the differences between people. Using biblical references we will explore the importance of treating others with care and respect. We will be finding out and celebrating the festival of Harvest and Baptism.</p>
