

Guided Reading

All children will take part in a daily guided read session where we will continue to focus on developing our fluency skills. Please ensure reading books, phonics books and reading records are in school daily so adults can share the children's progress with you. Please continue to support the children with their reading through phonics.

PSHE

In our Jigsaw lessons this term we will look at 'Dreams and Goals' and 'Healthy Me'. In these topics, we will discuss our aspirations for the future and how we can achieve these. We will also consider how to keep ourselves healthy.

Science

As Scientists we will be observing a range of common flowering plants. We will discuss what a plant needs to grow and will then use this knowledge to grow our own Bean Plant, linking to our English story; Jack and the Beanstalk.

We will also be making a new mop for Cinderella. We will investigate and evaluate a range of different materials and select the appropriate material for the job.

English

In English this term we will be looking at a range of traditional fairy tales. Through this we will focus on basic skills. We will continue to develop our use of cursive handwriting. We will continue to work on writing simple sentences using capital letters and full stops correctly. We will begin to retell traditional fairy tales, including a beginning, middle and end.

Home learning links: Read familiar fairy tales with your child. Discuss the characters, the setting and the key features found in a fairy tale.

Religious Education

In R.E. we will learn about the topic 'Looking at me, looking at you'. We will be discussing what makes an individual special yet different. We will read a range of faith stories and discuss the value of the individual and why they are unique.

Geography

As keen geographers we will develop our knowledge of the seasons by exploring the changes from Winter to Spring. We will add to our weather diaries to observe how the day length varies between them.

We will develop our locational knowledge by finding and locating the four countries of the U.K. and locating the capital city of England. We will also locate the waters surrounding the four countries and discuss the importance of these physical features.

Further to this, we will discover the place in which we live, by identifying Hull on a map.

Computing

We will develop our mouse and keyboard skills this term by creating a 'Wanted' poster for a fairy tale character.

We will also learn how to save and retrieve work from a folder.

P.E.

This term we will begin our Gymnastics and Dance unit. We will develop our balance and coordination skills.

Maths

As Mathematicians we will continue to further develop our Place Value knowledge by; counting to and across 50, reading and writing numbers from 1-20 in numerals, identifying and representing numbers using objects and pictorial representations, use mathematical language such as more than/less than and identify one more/one less. We will begin to count in multiples of twos, fives and tens. We will begin to represent and use number bonds and related subtraction facts within 20, as well as adding and subtracting one digit numbers up to 20. We will read, write and interpret mathematical statements involving addition (+), subtraction (-) and equals (=) signs. We will solve one step problems involving addition and subtraction, by calculating the answer using concrete objects, pictorial representations and arrays.

We will compare, describe and solve problems involving measures. We will begin to measure and record lengths, heights, capacity and volume. We will begin to record mass and weight.
