New Breakfast Club Arrangements

Dear Parent / Carer,

Thank you for your patience while we make arrangements to reopen breakfast club. We really do appreciate the impact of not having a breakfast club available for working parents, but the decision to delay the opening was made for the safety of our school community.

As you are all aware, government guidelines state that primary age children should be kept within bubbles of 30 where possible, but schools are able to run year group bubbles if needed. Therefore our current systems do not enable us to open the breakfast club in one location on the school site for all seven year groups as it has previously.

Therefore, for us to reopen breakfast club it will require the school to open **seven** different areas of the school for the different year groups to access. This has huge implications for us as a school as I am sure you will appreciate.

Breakfast club will be reopening on **Monday 21st September**. Due to limited space, numbers will have to be restricted. Therefore, please only book your child into breakfast club if you have no other option. The times will be strict and if any parent is not adhering to these times, their place will be withdrawn. **The drop off time for breakfast club will be strictly 7.50am-8am and the gates will not be opened until this time.** Children arriving after this time will not be able to enter the site and will not be able to attend the club.

There will strictly be no vehicles allowed on the school site during the breakfast club drop off period. Parents must park outside of the school site and walk their child into school. The barriers will remain closed, with only staff members having access to the site via an electronic fob system.

The breakfast club drop off point will be the KS1 playground for all year groups. Staff will be there to greet your child and take them to the designated location. The locations are as follows-

Reception- Children Centre (Room 1)
Year 1- Children Centre (Room 2)
Year 2- Children Centre (Room 3)
Year 3- Small Hall
Year 4- Dining Hall (Room 1)
Year 5- Dining Hall (Room 2)
Year 6- Dining Hall (Room 3)

Please do not try and drop your children off at these locations as staff will not be available to answer the door due to supervising the children.

Due to food hygiene standards, we are limited to the range of breakfast options that we can offer. Please see over the page a table which outlines the offer.

Strict Booking Arrangements

If you require a place at the breakfast club, you must go on to the School Money site to secure your child's place. If you have more than one child, please ensure you complete separate bookings. **The bookings will open this evening (Tuesday 15th September) at 7pm.** This will enable the food order to be placed by the catering manager. Therefore, bookings for the week commencing the 21st September must be made by 12pm on Thursday 17th September. The breakfast club cost remains at £1.50 per day. I really do appreciate that we are all living extremely busy lives and the current situation is making life that little bit more difficult for everyone but I must stress that using the online booking system is crucial to the opening of the club.

Registers will be produced from the online system and these will be taken each morning. Please do not send your child to breakfast club if a booking has not been made as we will not be able to accommodate them and you will be contacted to come and collect your child.

IMPORTANT- To those parents who have emailed or contacted the school requesting for their names to be put on the register for Breakfast Club. **Please note, this has not secured your place and you must follow the booking arrangements above.**
