



Last week we looked at the symbol of an ever lasting love that is used in weddings - a circular ring to show that love never ends.

• The two interlinked triangles form the six pointed Star of David which is the symbol of Judaism.


• The cross is the symbol that reminds Christians that Jesus died on the cross to save us.




