Communication and Language	We are reading Percy the Park Keeper One Snowy Night. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=K-8AAisU1w0 (Stop the story before we find out who is under the floorboard, who do you think is there?) A lot of animals came to stay in Percy's hut. Can you remember who they were? Why were the animals frightened? Who did they think was under the floor? Where did the animals sleep? Look back through the story to remind you. Who slept in the bed with Percy?				
PSHE	Percy was a very kind and caring man, sharing his home with the animals. We are going to think about sharing this week. Here are some ideas for you to talk about <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Talk about the following: What does it mean to share? 2. Who do we share our home with? 3. Who do we share our toys/belongings with? 4. Is it easy to share? 5. When do you find sharing hard? 6. How do you feel when someone shares their toys/belongings with you? 7. When you share your toys/belongings with someone do you think it makes them happy? 8. Can you think of anything that makes it easier to share? 9. What would the world be like if no-one wanted to share anything? 				
Phonics	Keep practising your speed sounds. Please email Mrs Perkins (jperkins@bricknell.hull.sch.uk) if you are unsure which sounds you should be working on and she will be happy to help you. Practise oral blending with your child- say the sounds of simple cvc words and see if they can tell you what the word is. If your child has brought any Ditty stories home, ask them to practise reading each one until they can read it fluently - no sounding out. Then have a go at writing it out. Don't forget to use pre cursive letters.

Maths	<p>This week we are revisiting numbers 1-5. Can you write them, use objects to represent them, find ways to make them using addition or subtraction? Find 1 more or 1 less than them, using objects or a number line.</p> <p>Can you remember the shapes we have learnt this term- triangle, circle, square and rectangle? What are the properties of each shape? How many sides do they have? Are they all the same size? Are the sides straight or curved? Do they have corners? How many?</p>
Writing	<p>Write what you can see on the sheet attached - bell, sack/bag, Santa, hat, tree. If your child is hearing the sounds in words let them try writing it themselves. If not, write it for them (in pre-cursive handwriting!) and let them copy, practising their letter formation. If your child is ready get them to write a caption e.g. a red hat.</p> <p>Also, keep practising writing their own name in pre cursive. If they can do it from memory confidently, show them how to write your name and the names of other family members. Thank you.</p>
