Communication and Language	Listen to this lovely story: Emily Brown and Father Christmas: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=IN4E2Yt_ILc Emily says that sometimes the old ways are the best ways. Talk to some older members of your family and ask them what Christmas was like when they were little. Are some things the same? Are some things different?				
PSHE	Emily Brown knows that Christmas is all about being kind and helpful. What kind and helpful things can you do at home? Can you help make the beds? Can you help put the washing in the washing machine? Can you help with the washing up or emptying the dishwasher? Can you help Hoover the house?				
Phonics	Keep practising your speed sounds. Please email Mrs Perkins (jperkins@bricknell.hull.sch.uk) if you are unsure which sounds you should be working on and she will be happy to help you. Practise oral blending with your child- say the sounds of simple cvc words and see if they can tell you what the word is. If your child has brought any Ditty stories home, ask them to practise reading each one until they can read it fluently - no sounding out. Then have a go at writing it out. Don't forget to use pre cursive letters.

Maths	This week we are focussing on number 6. Can you write it, use objects to represent it, find ways to make it using addition or subtraction? Find 1 more or 1 less than them, using objects or a number line. Can you draw a 6 sided shape? What is it called? Can you draw a repeating pattern that repeats after 6, for example red, red, red, blue, blue, blue or red, red, blue, green, green, blue.				
Writing	Draw a picture of your Christmas tree at home. Now label the tree. Include words such as branch, trunk, bauble, star, lights, and tinsel. Write the whole word if you can or just the initial, middle and final sounds using your phonic knowledge. Also, keep practising writing your own name in pre cursive. If you can do it from memory confidently, write your name and the names of other family members. Thank you.
