

Guided Reading

This term we shall read *The Girl Who Walked on Air*. This is an exciting story about an orphaned girl named Louie growing up in a circus.

English

As writers, we will focus on the following genres:

- A non-chronological report
- A set of directions (instructions to the fair)
- A diary entry about the fair
- A newspaper report

Maths

As mathematicians, there will be a strong focus on recalling number bonds and multiplication facts. Children will be using all of this knowledge to develop their fluency, reasoning and problem solving skills. Our focus units this term are: Number and place value, addition and subtraction and multiplication and division.

Art

As Artists, we will learn about tones and shading. We will spot shapes within pictures and recreate our own drawings.

Design Technology

As designers this term, we will become inventors. We will be designing, making and evaluating our very own Hull Fair ride.

Recovery Curriculum

This term, we will assess individual needs and give pupils the bespoke learning they require to succeed. We will address gaps in learning and will continue to support your child's emotional well-being. Lots of our learning this term will revisit past skills and rebuild confidence whilst maintaining a broad based and balanced curriculum.

Well-being

Each child will be encouraged to practise daily mindfulness and focus on their past, present and future emotions. We will be teaching the children to find positives in themselves and in others through a range of different activities. Also available to the children is a worry box (situated in each classroom) and creating a piece of art representing how we fit together as a class.

PHSE

In our Jigsaw lessons, we will be exploring what makes us special and unique. We will also be celebrating our differences as a class.

Science

As scientists, we will be learning about the changing world around us. We will be using our environment and making observations about how this changes throughout the year. We will also build on prior learning about the human body. We will ask questions and learn about a healthy diet. Later in the term, we will begin to learn about Light which will continue into the Spring term.

History

As historians, we will use primary and secondary resources to deepen our understanding around how Hull Fair has changed over time.

Geography

As geographers, we will explore the location of Hull Fair and how this compares to previous locations of Hull Fair. We will discuss the reasons as to why the location was changed. We will plot and plan routes using Digimaps and learn about the local land use comparing both physical and human features.

RE

We will be exploring 'remembrance' in the context of some major faith festivals; including Remembrance Day and festivals of remembrance (religious and secular). We will also learn about the Christmas story.

MFL—Spanish

This year, the children will be learning Spanish. They will learn Spanish greetings, days of the week, months of the year and animals.
