## Key Messages:

We would like to take this opportunity to say welcome back to all our amazing children and families.

At the start of the new school year, I would like to take the time to remind you of a few key messages for the year ahead.

## THE SCHOOL DAY

-  The doors will be open from 8:40am
-  The school day starts at 8:50am
-  The school day finishes at 3:20pm
-  Scooters and bikes must be walked with when on the school grounds
-  Due to insurance purposes, the children are unable to access the KS2 play equipment before or after school. Therefore, the gates to the KS2 playground will now open promptly at 8:35am by a member of staff.

## WATER BOTTLES

Please send your child to school each day with a water bottle.

We request that all bottles only contain water. Where possible, please avoid using metal water bottles as these can cause disruption during teaching time.



# UNIFORM

The school uniform is:

A navy jumper or cardigan

(please note PE hoodies are not permitted as school jumper)

A white polo shirt

Grey trousers, shorts, skirt, dress

Blue summer dress

Grey tights/socks

On your child's PE day, we ask them to come to school wearing their PE Kit, this is:

A plain navy pair of shorts or joggers

A plain navy hoody

A plain light blue t-shirt

Trainers (any colour)

For health and safety reasons, on PE days, children must not wear earrings to school; we are unable to provide tape and children will be asked to remove their earrings should they come to school wearing them. Any child who is wearing earrings and cannot remove them will not be allowed to do the physical part of the PE lesson.
