

Reading



As readers, during the Summer Term, the children will be concluding their class text: Kensuke's Kingdom. We will then move on to explore a picture text called 'The Way Home' by Libby Hathorn.

Writing



As writers, we will develop our narrative skills and learn how to integrate dialogue, action and characterisation to create an engaging story. We will look at the features of formal and informal writing by writing an e-mail to a friend and to a company on the same subject. We will become journalists and write a newspaper report, writing in a formal style.

Maths



As mathematicians, we will focus on algebra, ratio and statistics. Bringing all of our mathematical knowledge together, we will finish the year completing projects that focus on all areas of maths.

Science



As scientists, we will recognise the impact of diet, exercise, drugs and lifestyle on the way our bodies function

History



As historians, we will be investigating the Maya civilisation. Focussing on how Maya fits into a wider chronological pattern of other civilisations and periods we have studied in school, we will research their diverse culture and society.

Music



As musicians, children will learn to perform as an ensemble in our end of year production.

Art and Design



As artists this term, we will create a sculpture portrait of a person that expresses emotion through the use of form, pattern and texture.

Design Technology



As designers, we will be researching and designing to meet a specific brief. We will evaluate toy designs before planning our own. Using these plans we will create a 'steady hand game' using electrical circuits.

Physical Education



In P.E, We will be practising a variety of athletics skills, including running, jumping and throwing. Next, we will be practising our striking and fielding skills, developing a variety of hitting and fielding skills which we can use in game scenarios. We will also use what we have learned to evaluate our performances.

PSHE



In PSHE, we will look at 'Relationships' and 'Changing Me'. In these topics, we will discuss the importance of building healthy, positive relationships and how to cope positively with change.

Languages

In our language lessons, we will be using our prior knowledge to discuss how we spend our weekends. We will be using our grammar knowledge to write sentences, speak fluently using vocabulary from previous units.

Geography



As geographers, we will learn to use Ordnance Survey symbols, 6 figure grid references and to read and calculate distances from a scale. We will plan a route around the local area using OS maps. Furthermore, we will focus on how natural resources are distributed in different parts of the world and the impact of deforestation on a local and global scale.
