Maths



As readers, we will continue our phonics learning alongside Dear Greenpeace, Rainbow Fish, David Attenborough and various non-fiction texts. We will focus on fluency throughout the term by reading a range of texts linked to our foundation subject curriculum.

As writers, we will start the term by writing a letter from Greenpeace. We will learn the narrative The Selfish Giant and Superworm and we will write our own versions of the story. We will finish the term by writing a fact file about Endangered animals. Throughout these units of work, we will focus on sentence compositions, conjunctions, expanded noun phrases and basic skills.

As mathematicians, we will begin by exploring formal methods for addition and subtraction. Next, we will apply our understanding of place value, addition, and subtraction to concepts related to money. We will then study length and height, followed by mass, capacity, and temperature.

Computing

As digital citizens, we will be learning about pictograms. We will gather data

together and represent this electronically using software on the computer. We

will also learn about ESafety and why it is important to keep personal

information private.

Science



As scientists, we will be building on from our prior learning about materials and now learning about how materials can change. We will learn about suitability of materials and test these. In Spring 2, we will learn about plants. We will observe how plants grow from a seed and record our results. We will learn about Daniel Solander who is a significant scientist in botany.

History



As historians, we will explore the history of the Victorians. We will sequence significant events from this time period and describe a change beyond living memory. We will explain why an important person from this time period acted in the way they did and the impact of this.

Music



As musicians, we will learn use the programme Charanga. We will consolidate our musical notation and composition knowledge by identifying the pulse and steady beats in a piece of music. We will then learn to appreciate and appraise songs from different time periods and genres. We will learn how to sing and use an instrument alongside a piece of music.


Physical Education
