Letter formation and handwriting continues to be a huge priority this half term. The children will engage in daily writing tasks, handwriting sessions and fine motor activities. Your child will continue to

receive formation sheets every Friday. Please continue to refer to the Read Write Inc handwriting rhymes to support your child with the formation of each letter. We use the rhyme '*pinch the nib and lay it in it's nest*' to support the children to hold the

pencil correctly.



# chatta

We use Chatta in the classroom to support the children's oracy skills, which will then develop their ability to create and write stories. Last half term you were given an individual username and password for Chatta. We are pleased to see that some parents are using the app at home and sharing them with us.

You can create a Chatta about anything! We love to see what the children get up to outside of school and it is lovely to share as a class. We do not access your child's individual account and so you will need to copy the link to your child's Tapestry account (a step-by-step guide was given out at the Chatta workshop to support with this).

# Topic

This half term our topic is 'People Who Help Us'. Our topic will begin on **Monday 24<sup>th</sup> February** where the children can dress up as someone who has helped them. The children will look at the clothes needed for specific job roles and the reasons behind it. We will have visits from different professionals and services so that the children are able to ask questions and handle real-life equipment. The children will discover which vehicles are used by each service and why. If there are any parents who would be willing to come in and talk to the children about their job role, please speak to your child's class teacher.
